VAP Corporation is an entertainment company related to the Nippon Television Network Corporation. They produce music and films and also have their own internal studio.

Okamura's design concept of the entrance area was modelled on CDs and DVDs. The "disk" motif used for the meeting corner creates an environment suitable for any kind of meeting, from an important discussion to a simple conversation as it incorporates normal tables and chairs with sofas and slightly raised seating. The concept of the office was to create a studio office environment to inspire creativity while being practical at the same time. As such, Okamura designed a different work space for each function of the company. The production and advertising departments are built with a 120 degree desk lay-out, to facilitate both concentration and interaction when necessary. The sales and marketing division has island-style desks which allow for hot-desking and each section has space where the staff can get together for a meeting or simply relax. The concept, design and functionality were decided after liaising with designated project members from each department.
